
Dear Sir,

In answer to your letter of yesterday, I regret it will not be possible for the Museum to help you in your endeavour to obtain specimens of Boomerangs. Genuine articles are now very difficult to obtain, for even the wild natives use steel and iron instead of the stone chips or flakes that were once used for shaping and finishing the articles.
